Thank you for your support and membership of the Diamond Bullpen Club! The Camels currently sit at 6-10 after winning the series vs. Texas St. this past weekend. There were several encouraging bright spots this weekend as we are less than 2 weeks from the opening of conference play against UNCW. Jake Murray (CAA pitcher of the week) and Dave Rossow both put forward their best performances of the season. Jake has given us a chance to win every Friday night but was on another level this week. Dave switched to the 3B side of the rubber this week to create some more deception and had by far his best outing. Mason Smith will join the weekend rotation this week as we take on a UCONN team who is coming off a series win at Miami and was a Super Regional Team in 2024.

The offense averaged 8 runs per game over the weekend against a Texas St. pitching staff who had already accumulated wins vs. #1 Texas A&M and #19 Oklahoma St. Sunday was the most complete game the offense has played stealing 6 bases and having 6 extra base hits in a 15-4 run rule. Lukas Schramm was 3-4 with a double and HR in his first start back after fracturing his hand on opening day. Aaron Smigelski, who was a key piece of the Camels offense this fall, had his cast removed on Friday after breaking his hand in a preseason intrasquad and may return to action this weekend. The Camels strength of schedule currently sits at #18 in the country and that will get stronger as the next 7 games are against opponents with top 50 RPI's. Cooper Clark will receive a PRP injection and miss the remainder of the 2025 season, but Zach Sabers has felt good in his throwing program and could return to game action at the end of March.
