them will return in a few weeks. Mason Smith has been outstanding in his outings vs.ECU, Duke, and Liberty and will transition to the weekend as we move closer to conference play. Transfers Darnell Parker (SS), and Joey Morton(1B) have been great additions alongside returners Schuldt, Jackson Thompson, and Oster who have had consistent quality at-bats. Smigelski gets his cast off today, and Lukas Schramm (Kentucky transfer) should be back in the mix this weekend after being HBP in the hand on opening day.

The "one game only" Nobodies jersey was a success as it garnered a lot of attention throughout the country and we were able to make a profit to supplement the budget. DBC members were able to purchase the jerseys first at a \$100
